

Muslim American Leadership Alliance: US Muslims Poll

J.L. Partners polled a nationally representative sample of 503 Muslims online between April 10 to April 18, 2025.

Quotas were added to ensure representative data on region, partisan ID, age, gender, education, ethnicity, and density; and the sample was also weighted back to these same variables. The survey has a margin of error of 3.4%.
